RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING THAT CITY ORDINANCE #11-2017 CREATING A HISTORIC PRESERVATION COMMISSION BE ADOPTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL IN THE FORM PRESENTED TO THE PLANNING BOARD WITHOUT CHANGE.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of South Amboy (the "Council") has referred to the Planning Board of the City of South Amboy (the "Board") pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:55D-26, a proposed development regulation creating a Historic Preservation Commission referred to as Ordinance #11-2017, (the "Ordinance") and

WHEREAS, the Board has carefully reviewed a report and analysis prepared by the Board planner Angelo J. Valetutto, P.E., P.P. of the firm AJV Engineering; and


WHEREAS, the Board has determined that for the reasons set forth in the letter report of Angelo J, Valetutto PE. P.P. dated June 22, 2017 annexed hereto as Exhibit A, the Ordinance be adopted by the Council in its present form without change,.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Planning Board of the City of South Amboy in the County of Middlesex and State of New Jersey on this 28th day June 2017 as follows:

1. That this board strongly recommends the adoption of the Ordinance in its present form which Ordinance this board believes will provide significant benefits to the City of South Amboy and be consistent with goals and objectives of the City Master Plan.
