RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE PROFESSIONAL SERVICES FOR THE PLANNING
BOARD OF THE CITY OF SOUTH AMBOY

WHEREAS, the Planning Board (“the Board”) issued a Request for Proposals for Professional Legal Services to be provided to the Board; and

WHEREAS, the Board received one proposal submitted by Maraziti Falcon, LLP dated December, 2014; and

WHEREAS, the Board reviewed said proposal based on criteria outlined in the Request for Proposals and has determined that the firm of Maraziti Falcon, LLP 150 John F. Kennedy Parkway, Short Hills, New Jersey 07078 meets all criteria; and

WHEREAS, the Board has determined that the process utilized in selecting Maraziti Falcon, LLP meets the statutory requirements for award of a contract pursuant to the “Fair and Open” process of the Local Unit Pay-to-Play Law pursuant to N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20-4 et seq.; and

WHEREAS, the Board is satisfied that the services to be provided qualify as professional services in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A:11-5 (1) (a) (i); and

WHEREAS, the Board has determined to retain the services of Maraziti Falcon, LLP in accordance with the proposal of December, 2014.



1. The Chairman of the Planning Board is authorized and directed to execute an agreement with Maraziti Falcon, LLP setting forth the terms and conditions of


service for the duration of the Board's consideration of the aforesaid application and as set forth in the proposal of December, 2014.
